One full Undergraduate Scholarship will be awarded towards a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree in Graphic Design or Computer Animation, as well as partial scholarships worth \$20,000; \$15,000; \$10,000; and \$5,000.

2. Submit application with photographs of **3-5 pieces of your best artwork on a CD** or actual photos (CD and/or photos will not be returned). No actual artwork will be accepted.

Competition Information:

A panel of DMAC faculty will judge all students who enter and will choose a maximum of 30 students to participate in a one-day, two-round art competition. The 30 students selected will not have to pay an Admissions Application fee, should they choose to apply to DMAC for their education.

The deadline for all entry forms is March 31st, 2010. All entries must be postmarked. Each student participating should come prepared with their idea and materials that will be needed for this competition; reference imagery is encouraged. This competition will be judged based on creativity and overall design composition.

Digital Media Arts College will provide **easels** and **illustration boards** for each student.

Theme: Freestyle

The first round will consist of 30 Semifinalists. They will have a set theme to create an illustration of their choice. We want to see a reflection of your personal style in your artwork. Each group will have 4 hours to work on their illustration. After the first round is completed, a panel of judges will determine the 10 finalists who will return for the final round of the competition.

The finalists will be announced at 1:30 pm on May 1st.

Final Round

2pm – 6pm

Themes (Please choose one of the following):

Mythology – Illustration to be based on any mythological creature or character.

Environmental – Illustration based on that of a landscape, cityscape or seascape.

Surrealism – Illustrations that feature the element of surprise, unexpected juxtapositions and non sequitur.

After this round is completed, the finalists will be judged.

The winners will be announced at **6:30 pm** on the day of the competition.

Accepted media for this competition include: Pencil, Colored Pencils, Markers, Acrylics, (No Oil Paints please), Pastels (soft and oil), Charcoal, Watercolors.

Non-Acceptable media: Computers, photography, Oil Paints
